



The On Demand Flows trigger in Zenphi allows you to run Flows manually by selecting it in the flow list in your flow designer. This is useful for tasks that need to be performed only sometimes with no regularity or when testing Flows. Once you have published your Flow, start it from the flows list.

Short about the On Demand Flow trigger:

No Start Parameters: Unlike some other triggers, the On Demand Flow Trigger does not have any start parameters.

To configure the trigger you have the following tabs available:

- The **Settings** is empty, there is nothing to configure for this to run.
- The **Usage** tab allows viewing of flow actions that use the trigger's output.
- The **Error Handling** tab decides what to do in case of an error to launch the Flow.
 - **Retries** - lets you configure how many times the action should be retried if there is an error.
 - **When this step errors** - gives you the option to *Fault the Flow* or ignore the error and *Continue to the next step*. Useful if you have a second layer of Error handling in the flow.

The **output** from the trigger offers the following information:

- **Start Time** - The date and time when the flow ran.
- **Initiator** - The user who started the flow run.
 - **Email Address** - The email address of the user.
 - **Name** - The full name of the user.

A simple yet often used trigger during the development phase when building new flows.
